The Remembering of our Dead, and prayers for those who have died.

When I was here before there was a banner, that we could all write the names of our Dead and we would pray for them. That tradition seems to have fallen away, and while I would love to have the tradition resume, I can't sew, nor can I hang the banner. How do we make a point of remembering our Dead as is the Custom in the month of November? Would there be someone who could sew the banner. It is late, but we could keep it down for the first week of the month, then it could go up.

Meetings, in talking with the priests and deacon, we wanted to put this idea before you. That we have our Parish meetings at 7.30. I have found that there are sorts of meeting times from the early evening till late. Some families wait for their meals until after the meetings, and for the priests, we are often rushed or having meals on the run, or late into the night, Not good. Would it be possible to say, we have our meetings for Parish at 7,30 pm. Could I suggest also we try to practice a discipline of having meetings only for an hour. Then the burden of meetings and getting decisions to go forward in our parish would be helpful.
