<b>Brief Background Of Why We Are In This Position</b> having the roof cleaned, inspected the cladding and reports were completed by 3 different people. All reports recommended new build. The repair cost would be approx \$5m without a life span. The consensus was to rebuild at a higher cost with longer longevity. <b>Presbytery</b> - Fr Peter recommended a walk through for a full picture. <b>Hall</b> – an integrated facility with the school. Moving forward and being fit for purpose. Feedback from the school is that they are keen to join forces in this area.	
<b>Purpose of the Committee – the starting point for the committee.</b>  The representatives of the Parish and so it's important to take on feedback from the parish so that they have a voice and it is considered however the final recommendation is made by the committee.  Ethnic Community Groups to be invited to a presentation on what the project is and the status. This will give the groups an opportunity to learn about the project and offer feedback within a set time frame.  An agreement that the committee is a group and not acting as individuals. Respect and trust with the discussions and decision making. We agree that we will only speak respectfully and positively about each other and the project.
