WELCOME TO ST ANNE'S BISHOP LOWE!

Dear Parishioners

Our Bishop Lowe will be visiting St Anne's this coming weekend (17-18 Sept). While here, he will celebrate Confirmations (10am Sun Mass) followed by morning tea. He also plans to celebrate Sat 5.30pm and Sun 8am Masses. The Catholic faith here in greater Auckland is under his care. Therefore, legally he is the single owner of St Anne's Church and property. This flows from his spiritual responsibility. So he is coming to his own 'home' and community – even though it is for the first time here as Bishop. The parish priest and assistants are only his 'vicars' (delegates), so stand aside when the Bishop is here. Welcome Bishop Steve! Nau mai, Haere mai!

CONFIRMATION FIRST THEN HOLY COMMUNION – WHY?

Confirmation is the last step of Baptism. When baptism is complete a person is permitted to receive Holy Communion. In the early church the Bishop did the baptisms. But, as numbers increased, he delegated this to his priests. But every so often all the newly baptised would gather, the Bishop would visit and



complete their baptism at one 'hit' – with Confirmation. With initiation complete, Holy Communion followed. However, in about 1910, Pope Pius X permitted Holy Communion for 7/8 year olds (before their Confirmation).

It had pastoral appeal, but shakey theology and most bishops have returned to the ancient practice. Young St Anne's candidates – Kia Kaha! We're praying for you on the 18th!
