Dear Parishioners

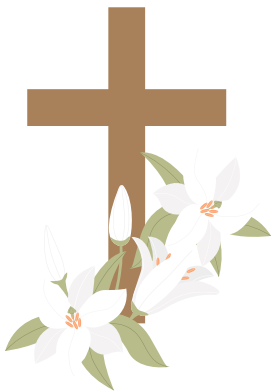


Firstly I would like to thank you all for being so welcoming. Fr Peter asked me to introduce myself to you all...

Ladies' Toilet - Children have been jumping on the toilet seats and even onto the tank on the wall (footprints show this...) causing flooding and expensive damage. The sanitary bin has been emptied over the floor.

Men's Toilet - Graffiti on the walls.

Single Outdoor Toilet has repeatedly been damaged making it unusable.

Not surprisingly the repairs and cleaning are costly...
Can I ask please, if you have children, to accompany them to the toilets - to ensure good behaviour, but also to keep them safe. That is part of the Diocese Safeguarding Policy. For their own safety, they should never be there unsupervised.

KNITTING GROUP



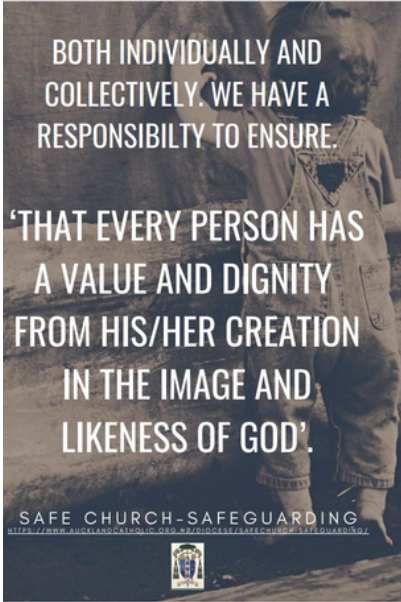
