

### Helen & Harry SHUTKOWSKI

A presentation of a Shield to St Anne's School, on behalf of the Shutkowski family, at the end-of-year prizegiving 2022, gifted to the School in Helen's memory of the 20+ years she taught there.... Helen will be remembered by many who attended 1970's -1990s as a remarkable inspirational teacher, RE Co-ordinator, deputy principal and acting principal. The Shield to be awarded each year to teacher/or pupil excelling in Religious Studies.

Both Helen and Harry contributed to parish life in many other ways; Helen in Confraternity of Christian Doctrine, Justice Peace Development & Caring Group activities. Sadly, Helen passed away in Nov 2020. RIP.





Harry, a quiet, private man, unobtrusively actioned a great many maintenance and repair works around St Annes --- way back when the field behind the Weymouth Rd property was just a mud bog, Harry quietly without any fan-fare organised the drainage and development into a grass playing field and had tennis court area sealed...another was sorting the problem on Russell Rd, where the flagstones and tiles were lifting due to tree roots; and that perspex protection in front of Sacred Heart Statue was Harry & son David's generous time and talent..... The Shutkowskis and Mazurs settled in Manurewa when the Motorway was being developed.. both Harry (project Engineer) and Tadek (Accountant) employees of the Contractor doing the extension from Redoubt Rd to Takanini, had the opportunity of purchasing sections in the new Hillpark development -- both couples married on the same day, and moved into their homes January 1961.



Helen and Harry raised 5 children, the Mazurs 4 children, parishioners and neighbours Anne and Neville Hay, 3 sons - the families gathered regularly after **Sunday Mass** 


# **Legion of Mary**
