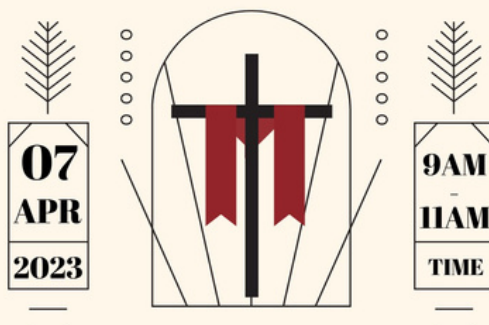

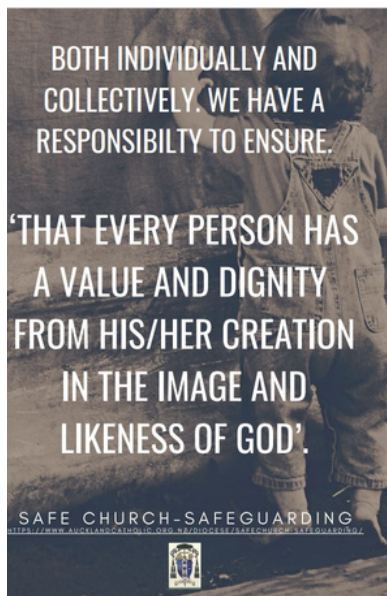
OUR BANK IS CHANGING!
