I taught at St Anne's in 1971, and was known as
Sr.M.Loyola.

I had the second year infants.

The school had expanded - two new classrooms
above the hall, and 2 on the section between
convent and presbytery, with a principal's and
secretary's office, and staff room.

Sr.M.Rosario was cook,
Sr.M.Majella was music
teacher.

Staff at school were:

Sr.M.Enda, Sr Clare
Marie, Pat Moverley,
Sr.M..Assumpta, Helen
Schutkowski,
Sr.M.Mercia and myself.



It was my first year out of
training school, and I had a
great class. Some of the
children I taught were -
Megan and Nigel McGlone,
Brian Glass, Mary Hunter,
Patrick McMillan,
Tina Johnson, Maurice
O'Connell, Philip Sargeant,
and Anthony Hortle.

Friendships forged then, still continue today
especially with Ngaire McGlone and her
family. Children in those days respected their
teachers and did what they were told. They took a
pride in their school and their work. Discipline was
almost unheard of, those were the days!!!!

In 2018 I celebrated my Golden Jubilee, and with me
being the only religious sister from the parish, it's
time for someone else to answer God's call - will it

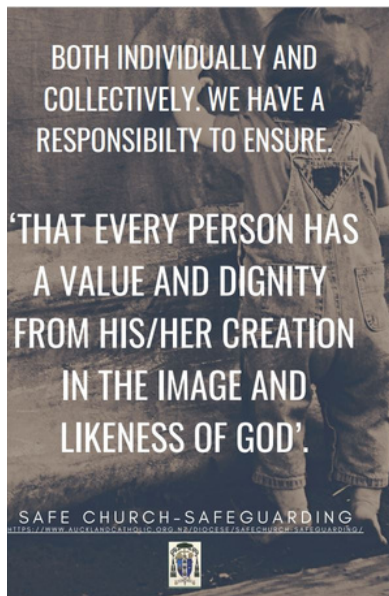


OUR BANK IS CHANGING!
