We start by looking deeply at the 'ache' of human longing and finish by delving into the Apostles Creed.


This series opens the eyes of our hearts to the hope of infinite bliss and fulfilment in Christ.

The Diocese has instructed all parishes to get new bank accounts so we can be inline with legislation. We will have more details to follow in upcoming bulletins but for now, know that change is


coming, it's not a scam and it's all endorsed by the Bishops office. For those of you paying online, we will be reaching out to you via email with the new details in the next few weeks.
