Every little bit helps to keep our parish to spread the Good News.



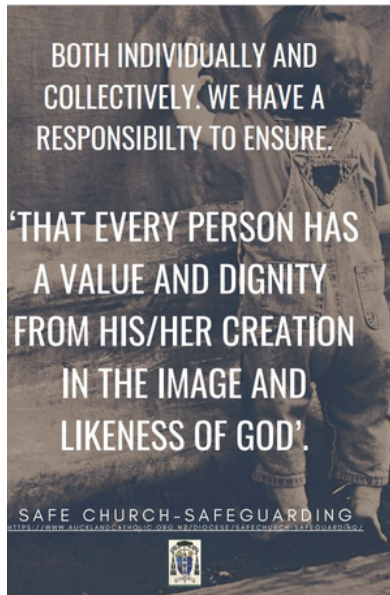


OUR BANK IS CHANGING!
