# IN OUR PARISH

Frances Mazur looks back...

Who are the Vincentians? a little  
background: Founded in 1833 by a young  
Frederic Ozanam. Frederic was a 20yrs-  
old student in Paris, walking through the  
poorer suburbs on his way to University  
observed the conditions of the poor and  
underprivileged.

He discussed with fellow students the need to do something  
and the Society was formed, in honour of the saint Vincent de  
Paul of 200 years earlier, who declared "LOVE THE POOR,  
HONOUR THEM, MY CHILDREN, AS YOU WOULD CHRIST  
HIMSELF" - - now a world-wide Society.



Paul Burns provided a little history of his

memories of St Vincent de Paul in our Parish...  
The Society introduced to St Anne's Manurewa  
by our first Parish Priest Fr Michael Kenefick,  
requesting Ray Peguero form a Conference here.  
Ray became first President.

Some of the early members were Dick and Lila  
Reid, Frank Turner, and other notable  
Vincentians were Gus Driessen, Jan Laurent,  
involved in working with refugees.

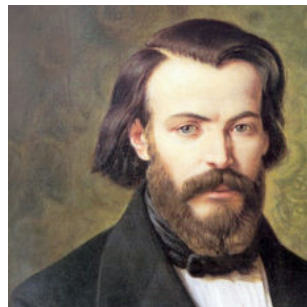
Our first Shop was located in the McKean block  
of shops, Renzi Hall the Manager for many years,  
followed by Regina Baptist, Betty Peguero, Val  
Klay, Stella Jarka.

John Leilua, a faithful and regular Vincentian  
first had a Trailer and later a Van to pick up and  
deliver furniture, also food parcels.

Russ Toyne was instrumental in finding the  
Shop in Halver Road, making the Society more  
visible. With the shop becoming too small we  
looked for something bigger and more central  
and found our present site on the Station  
Rd/Great South Rd corner. Also involved over the  
years many volunteers giving outstanding  
service and care to those calling on St V de Paul  
in times of need.
