Hotline to Hillsborough* --choir practices -- church linen laundered (the "best" alb for the Bishop)-- etc. Anxiety --- church too small, so many wanted to see "our" Leonard being ordained Arranging of the flowers -- expression of joy. Bishop's permission; if fine, ordination outside! Sunday 12th -- glorious weather, a gift from heaven. Schoolground 1 pm -- people, chairs, microphones -happy confusion. How does one shake hands with the Bishop with tin of Brasso in one hand, dusters in the other? No Mother's Day dinner -- a snack and then back for final preparations. People arriving in happy anticipation of the event --(Yes, we knew Leonard when he was a little boy...) Entrance procession --- Look, there goes Father.....and Father..... The choir charmingly dressed -- singing like angels --- guote from the new priest. Father Lenihan's Irish brogue, calling Leonarrd Charrles Danverrs to come forward Leonard answering in his clear steady voice. The laying-on of hands by his fellow priests. The first blessing for his sister -- what did he say to make her shake with laughter? Meeting old friends in the Hall afterwards ---Leonard's first Mass in his "own" church --- brother and sister distributing Communion. A first blessing, this time for us all. Treasured moments --chuckles and tears.... Leonard's loud "pff" at the end of hundreds of blessings. The beautiful "ordination cake" --- the art of giving a piece to everyone and keeping the children's fingers off. Dear Leonard, with the whole of St. Anne's people behind you, your halo simply cannot slip!
