

Then one day, sometime in the early 80's a young man appeared from nowhere asking if he could practise on the organ? Could he ever! Not only did Michael Fischer prove to be a very able and talented musician, he did wonders with the choir and had us singing the Litany of the Saints for ordination Mass of Chris Rae.

Michael also wrote out in beautiful hand-script many of the overhead transparencies - some may still exist, see copy of letter, each hand-written to choir members. Michael adapted music for the organists and worked closely with the Liturgy committee to introduce "RENEW" . He was farewelled by parish "Hi-Di-Hi" evening as he set off on his travels to Europe....
