ANOINTING OF THE SICK

This Wednesday at Midday Mass

God's Healing Touch:

Anointing of the Sick (the sacrament of healing) will be celebrated this Wednesday (21 June) during the midday Mass. It is for those who are ill or elderly or in need of God's healing touch in the Holy Oils.

Larishioners

If you know of someone, a family member or friend, who would like to be anointed please let them know. You might also offer to take them if they are unable to get there themselves. It is up to each person to get their own transport.



Every Two Months:

Every second month on the third Wednesday we will celebrate a Mass with Anointing, until the end of the year. Let's see how it goes. This year's dates are: Wed June 21, Wed August 16, Wed Oct 18. The December Anointing Mass will be a little earlier on the Wed Dec 6 to avoid the Christmas rush. The usual weekday Mass will take just a few minutes more (from 30 to 45 minutes). The anointing is given to those who wish after the Gospel.

Please do inform your sick or elderly friends and family and invite them. This is a moment of God's gentle presence of healing and peace to them in their struggles and suffering.


Renewal Fundraising Update
