Our Knitting Group are running a craft stall next Sunday 2 July at the 8 & 10am Masses. NOT ONLY THAT...

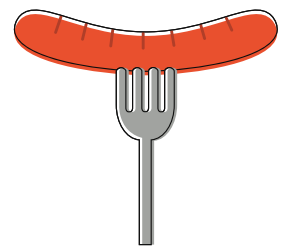
Raffle:

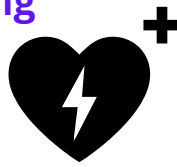

TANGATA WHENUA

Frances Mazur looks back...

The connection with Manurewa goes back to the Māori Legion of Mary about 1958 with Mill Hill priest Fr Haring, the Māori Missioner for Manurewa and South Auckland. Masses were celebrated monthly, shared successively by Fathers Haring, Van Enckevoort and Tate. In the 1960's a Māori/Pakeha Committee formed for fundraising towards Te Unga Waka in Epsom, Auckland. Concerts, Queen Carnivals and Housie evenings were popular, the Housie organised by Mrs Ada Daniels..

One particular concert long remembered by many, was the performance of a very young talented soprano Kiri Te Kanawa, on the verge of her international singing career - how blest we were.. what a treat!



From the very beginnings of our Parish, Māori hapori whenua have walked alongside us in all our liturgies and activities. Names such as Pat Te Awhitu a teacher for many years at St Anne's School, Joe & Bella Harris remembered as part our Christian Family Living Group, Doug Tepania, Toia Lucas, and Waina Emery recalled.

In 1991 The Sisters of Compassion were given the mandate by Bishop Dennis Browne and Father Henare Tate for Maori Pastoral Care with Mrs Agnes Beach a constant companion and guide of Sr Rosalie in the support of her work and assisting her in things Māori.

On December 1991 the parish Marae was opened. A classroom moved from Weymouth Rd property. Bishop Max Takaura Mariu visited for Māori Mass, March 1992. Planning in 1985 for our current church records that "consideration must be given to the ethnicity of the parish community with it's cultural diversity."

In 1983 the pataka (storehouse for food) was created around our tabernacle, highlighting the Year of Indigenous People. On top a carving of a wooden cross depicting the Trinity - representing God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit :: 12 paua-shell eyes (6 on each side) seemingly representing the 12 apostles...

One could say one side holds the three baskets of knowledge handed down to the apostles to enhance their Language and knowledge.
