Parish Novena to St Anne:

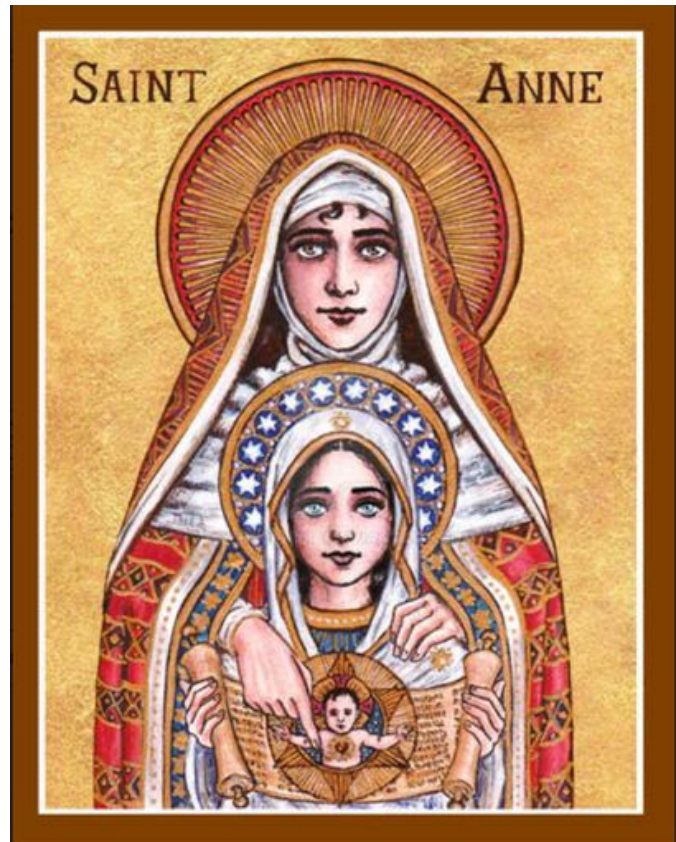
Tue 26 July – Wed 26 July. Say this short prayer for the Nine Days: "Good St Anne/ mother of her /who is our life our sweetness and our hope/ pray for us."

St Anne is called simply "good" since the early church (AD 60-400). She and Joaquim are not mentioned in the bible, but clearly Mary had a mum and dad. Their names come down to us from church traditions and writings that were not included in the bible.

At Mass each day, the priest will lead the prayer after Holy Communion. A Novena (Nine Days) comes from the Acts of the Apostles. The disciples and Mary waited in prayer in the Upper Room for the coming of the Holy Spirit (Acts 1:12-14). This was for nine days – from Ascension Thursday (40 days after Easter Sunday see Acts: 1:3) to Pentecost Sunday (Pente-coste = 50 Nights after Easter Sunday) That in between period of anticipation and prayer was the first Novena. Nine days of prayer is a popular Catholic way of preparing for a feast-day, birthday, medical procedure, exam etc.

The School (St Anne's) will celebrate this Feast on July 26 Wed with Mass at 9am. This date is the official date of St Anne and St Joaquim, but the parish will Sunday-ise the feast. Enjoy your day staff and students!

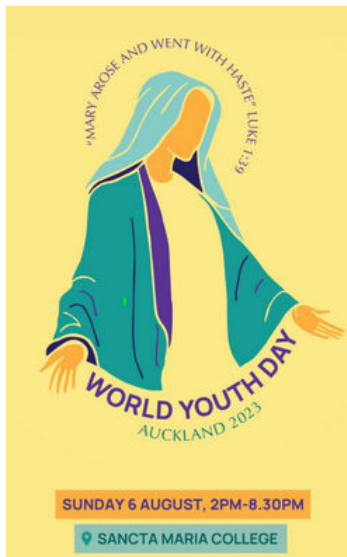
