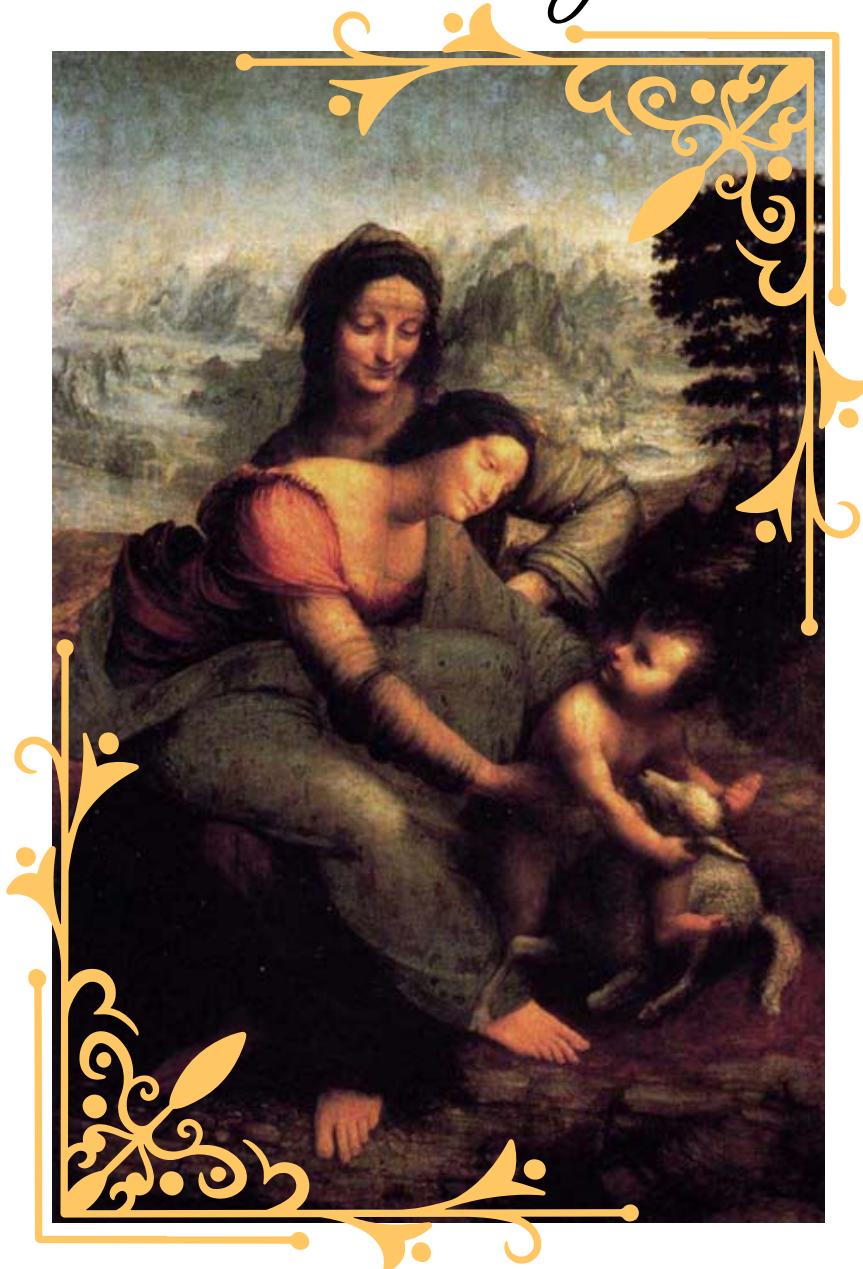

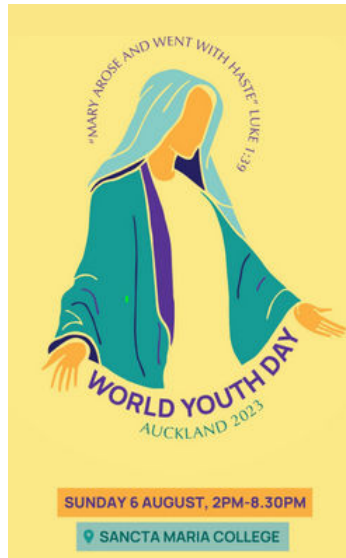

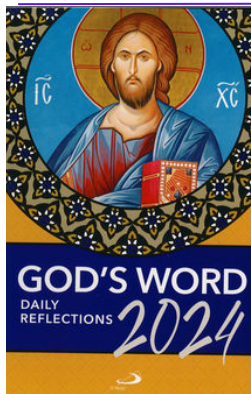

Wow! A huge thank you to everyone who was able to contribute to our 2nd collection at the Sunday Masses last weekend. This was a fundraiser suggested by a number of parishioners. Every offering is genuinely appreciated, cash or Eftpos, no matter how small. Offerings totalled a stunning \$2,912.20. Thank you all for your generosity!
