



IN OUR PARTSH RENEWAL UPDATE



Last Sunday at the 8 & 10am Masses Cyrilet raised \$287.00 from the sale of her donated avocado trees which she had grown from seed over the last 2 years. Thank you so much Cyrilet and all those who bought trees, may your generosity bear much fruit in the coming years!

Our Bonus Ball fundraiser sold out by 10am Mass and with donations raised a further \$510.00, and generous parishioners also gave \$90 through Renewal Envelopes put in the Mass collection baskets. A total of \$887.00 was raised on the weekend for our church rebuild.
