GENERAL ELECTION 2023

As we prepare for the Upcoming General Election 2023, The NZ Catholic Bishop's Conference often reminded the faithful about the teaching of our Lord Jesus Christ before choosing who to vote for. They are currently working on pamphlets and a Statement to assist all Catholics in this Election.

Bishop Steve Lowe's Diocesan Justice and Peace Commission in partnership with Caritas Aotearoa NZ will once again be hosting this Election Forum in our St Anne's Community. Six major political parties have been invited to attend to this forum where we will raise our concerns on some of the issues that are affecting the wider Community. The Catholic Church follows the teaching of Jesus Christ to ensure that all are working for the common good of all people and NOT just some people.

The Theme Chosen for the evening is "Working for the Common Good of All"

Deacon Sanele Poluleuligaga (Executive of the Commission) is Co-ordinating this event with a team of young people from various parishes in Auckland. Advertisement have gone out on Social media and parishes of the Auckland diocese to encourages all parishes to join this forum. We are expecting a big crowd on the night as was in last time. The panel have prepared some burning questions for the Candidates on the night. There will be an opportunity also, be given to the Community (floor) to ask a couple of questions on the night. These are some of the works that the Diocesan Justice and Peace Commission have been involved in to ensured that families and Communities are not neglected by our Leaders in parliament.

Submissions to Parliament on Exploitation of Migrant Workers Bill, 2023 Budget, Climate Change, Aborting of Children, Cost of Living and many more The Organizing Committee and I are expecting 400 plus audience on the night and we want to ensure that their voice will be heard.

With Candidates from all the major parties attending and fronting up to answer our burning questions. Questions will come from our young people of South Auckland parishes, and this forum will be facilitated by Pat Sneddon, well-known Catholic businessman and entrepreneur.


