REBUILD : WHAT'S THE LATEST?

As Chair of the Finance Committee I delivered an update of where we are in regard to Renewal at St Anne's Parish. This update was given over Labour weekend, and for those parishioners who were away here is an overview:

Where we are at: Acknowledgement must be given to Fr Brian Prenderville and the members of the Finance Committee and Parish Pastoral Council who identified and initiated the need for Renewal at St Anne's – building inspections were undertaken, quotes obtained and discussions held with Bishop Pat Dunn and the Diocesan team.

Nov 3rd 2020: a Parish meeting was held to consider the options for the renewal project. Rebuild was the chosen option.

Dec 20th 2020: a formal letter was sent to Bishop Pat Dunn signed by Fr Brian Prenderville PP, John Thurston FC Chair and AJ Scorrington, PPC Chairperson.

Jan 15th 2021: we received a letter of support for the project from Bishop Dunn.

March 2021: Fr Peter was appointed Parish Priest, and Bishop Dunn sent another letter supporting the rebuild.

July 2021: an initial meeting was convened with a further meeting scheduled for **September 2021**. The pandemic impacted on the project, as did changes in circumstances for parishioners – now the Steering Control group needs to be reformed.

Where to from here: The General Manager of the CDA is preparing a 10 year plan for Bishop Steve Lowe, and we need to be in this plan. The procedure to be followed when embarking on a building programme is laid down by the Dioceses. Father Peter and I have been consulting and following the requirements prior to completing a brief which has been submitted. The next step will be to select the Steering Control Group which will have delegates from the CDA as members.

Nov 2023: Brief completed.

We need to do some repairs: We have been advised to keep up maintenance on the existing buildings for five years – you will see some work being undertaken over the coming weeks. The Interim Funding Committee, formed in May, being led by Des Kiely will be giving a full update early December. Thank you for your support of events that have been held. Prayer, commitment and on-going support is what is asked of all of us. Thank you for continuing to grow our community of faith.

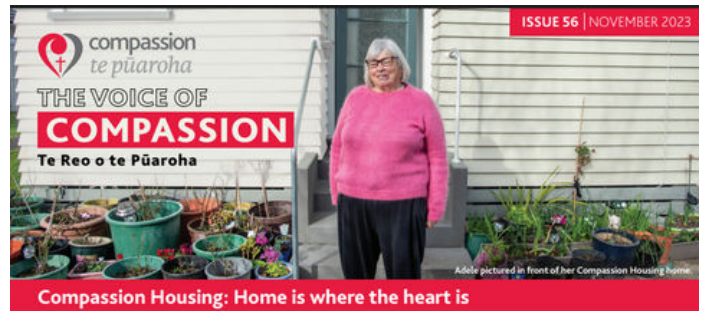
