



Fr Paul Shannahan RIP



Let us pray for Fr Paul Shannahan SM who died at Nazareth Village in Christchurch on Saturday 18 November.

Fr Paul was a much loved parish priest here at St Anne's 1979-84. He led the first community of Marists who arrived in 1979. Plans to expand and then move from Weymouth Road began in earnest. Paul gave his very best energies to building up the faith life here and responding to the needs of countless individuals.

To the end of his life, St Anne's held a very special place his heart. Whenever I saw him over the last three years, he would ask for news and recall people and events with great affection from his years here.

He was ordained in 1964. His funeral was on Friday 24th November at Sacred Heart Church in Addington Christchurch followed by burial at Waimairi Cemetery. He was 88.

May he now be with the Lord in glory.


ANOINTING MASS AND CUPPA: THUR 7 DEC MIDDAY


