it's Time

VOTE

Election 16/17 December

Elections for the pastoral committee will be on 16/17 December. At the four Masses that weekend each person 16 years and over will receive a pen and voting paper with the names and photos of the candidates. You will be asked to tick your preferred candidates.

Candidates

The names and photos will be printed in the bulletin next week so you can think and pray about your choices well in advance. As you are probably aware, I have been asking around the parish groups for good nominees and thankfully already there is a good muster of excellent people who have agreed to go on the list. Thank you! By next week that list should be ready.

What Sort of Person?

The pastoral committee is about pastoral – eg catechesis, spreading the gospel, outreach. By **researching**, **reflecting on** and **recommending** the "three R's" – they give good advice to the priests on pastoral matters. The members should be people already active, as team workers and leaders in pastoral.

They take their faith seriously, bring people together and understand what works among their groups. Policy comes from the bishop. Knowing how to implement it at parish level is another level of wisdom and listening.





Synodal

This way of working is particular to the church – called synodal. It has its challenges – it can be slow. But the results are positive and worthwhile. It works.



Back in July our parish Knitting Group wowed us with their purpose, their craft and their generosity and raised over \$2,600 for the Renewal. Now they're back with a Christmas themed craft stall this weekend at ALL Sunday Masses 2/3 December, including Saturday/Sunday evening 5:30pm and 5:00 pm Masses! FYI...all parents and grandparents who may have a baptism coming up, our knitting group received a donation of some white lace fabric and have crafted some beautiful baptism gowns - don't miss this one-off opportunity to buy one and support the Renewal at the same time!

Alongside the craft stall we're raffling the choice of an amazing hand knitted nativity set (usual sell \$200) OR a handcrafted quilt and blanket, winner chooses! 100 tickets at \$5/ticket, raffle tickets on sale from Sunday 26 November 5:00pm Mass through to Sunday 3 December 10am Sunday Mass when the raffle will be drawn. There were strong ticket sales at last Sunday 5pm Mass, don't miss out, tickets will sell out! Eftpos will be available as usual.

God works in mysterious (and anonymous) ways....last week we did mention to expect the unexpected....and this week the unexpected has happened!.... the Golden Oldies have contributed \$11,840 to the Renewal!

The Golden Oldies? That's what we asked, who are the Golden Oldies? Over the last 3 years they've raised close to \$30,000 for the Renewal! I think I'm allowed to let you know that this anonymous group got together to assist with fundraising when Fr Brian announced back in 2020 that a big project was coming up for Church renovations. During the difficult Covid times they were supported and encouraged to keep going by our priests and currently they are made up of 13 very staunch, committed and faithful elderly women and men who wish to contribute to the Renewal anonymously and quietly. 2 members have passed on. The Golden Oldies have raised funds through bake sales on Sundays, contributing \$50 from their monthly pensions, and other personal donations from family and friends. They are an example for all of us. Thank you thank you.
