LISTENING TO JESUS Mark 9, 2 – 10 2nd SUNDAY OF LENT

We have less and less time to listen. It can be difficult to approach the hearts of others calmly and without prejudice. Locked up in our own problems, we can pass by people without listening to anyone. It is easy to forget the art of listening.

To be a believer is to live by listening to Jesus. It is from this listening that true Christian faith is born.

On the **"mountain of transfiguration**" the disciples are frightened when they are enveloped by the shadows of a cloud. They hear the words: **"This is my beloved Son, listen to him!"**

The experience of listening to Jesus to the core can be painful, but it is exciting. He is not the one we had imagined from our schemas and agendas. Almost without our realising it, he tears us away from our cherished securities to draw us into a more authentic life.

We meet, at last, someone who speaks the ultimate truth. Someone who knows what to live for and what to die for. Something tells us from within that he is right. There is truth in his life and in his message.

If we persevere in patient and sincere listening, our life can be illuminated with new light. We begin to see everything more clearly. We discover the most humane way to face the problems of life and the mystery of death. We become aware of the big mistakes we can make.

We must take more care in our families and communities to listen faithfully to Jesus. Listening to him can cure us of this world's blindness. It can free us from almost inevitable discouragement and cowardice. It

can reinvigorate our faith.
