EASTER SUNDAY - THE RESURRECTION OF THE LORD

WHERE TO LOOK FOR THE LIVING ONE. Jn 20, 1 - 9

Faith in Jesus, risen from the dead, did not come easily to the early Christians .

Mary of Magdala seeks the Crucified One in the midst of darkness, "while it was still dark". Naturally, she seeks Him "in the tomb". But the tomb is empty. He is not there!

The others do not find Jesus in the tomb either. They are told: "Why do you look for the living among the dead? He is not here. He is risen".

Faith in the Risen Jesus does not happen with us either, just because we have heard since we were kids. It comes seeking him not in rigid and boring repetition but where there is life and creative power: where we wash the feet of others; break bread together in worship; in song; in action in everyday centering in Him and living as He did. That's where we find Him.

It's not just an historical event 2,000 years ago. Jesus the Crucified One lives in us in our striving, in our forgiving and our washing of others' feet. That's where He is the Risen One.




