Fourth Sunday of Lent

GAZE ON JESUS ON THE CROSS John 3 14-21

According to Jesus, the light that illuminates is to be found in the Crucified One. Have you ever seen and felt love from looking at the tortured Jesus on the cross?

Ever since we were kids we have seen the Cross and the Crucified one. Perhaps distracted, our gaze does not see the light that lifts us in the darkness, in the hardest and most difficult moments?

Those outstretched arms, can no longer embrace children, those nailed hands cannot caress the lepers or bless the sick. But He is there with his arms open to welcome, embrace and sustain our poor world, broken by so much suffering.



From that face extinguished by death, from those eyes that can no longer look tenderly at sinners and wretched ones, from that mouth that cannot cry out its indignation for the victims of so many abuses and injustices, from all shines a light that comes out from surrounding darkness
