SECOND SUNDAY OF EASTER

"THE CHILDREN HAVE FORGOTTEN HOW TO SMILE"

Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

This Divine Mercy Sunday and Easter Time, Pope Francis speaks to the whole world:

"The tomb of Jesus had been sealed with a great stone. Today too, great stones, heavy stones, block the hopes of humanity. Jesus Christ is risen! He alone, the Lord of Mercy has the power to roll away the stones that block the path to life. He, the living One, is himself that path. He is the Way: the way that leads to life, the way of peace, reconciliation, and fraternity."

Pope Francis especially speaks to the whole world through children:

"How much the precious gift of life is despised! How many children cannot even be born? How many die of hunger and are deprived of essential care or are victims of abuse and violence? How many lives are made objects of trafficking?"

He speaks of so much strife in our world: hunger, violence, trauma, and death: Israel, Palestine; Gaza; Ukraine; Syria; Lebanon; Western Balkans; Rohingya people (Myanmar); Sudan; Haiti; Sahe; horn of Africa; Kivu region, (Congo); Capo Delgado (Mozambique); and millions of migrants everywhere.

"How much suffering we see in the eyes of the children: they have forgotten how to smile! With their eyes they ask us: why? Why all this death?"

Lord I trust in thee.

For the sake of your sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

MINISTERS OF THE WORD AND EXTRAORDINARY MINISTERS OF HOLY COMMUNION


