THIRD SUNDAY OF EASTER

WITH THE VICTIMS Lk 24, 35 - 48

God has not raised up just anyone; he has raised up a crucified one, a victim, someone who has been persecuted and rejected. **Jesus is the 'God of the victims'**, so that justice triumphs over injustice, the victim over the executioner. **Jesus did this by keeping his total trust in God to the end.**

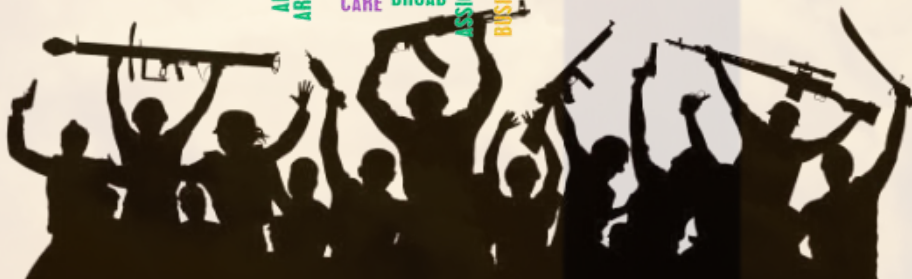
Moreover, this victim, the crucified one, lets us know that his God loves the poor and forgives sinners; he is always in solidarity with every victim.

On the cross, he keeps his mouth shut and silent, not because he is powerless, but because he identifies with those who suffer. They must know that they are not sunk in loneliness because God himself is in their suffering which will end in resurrection.

Pope Francis in his Easter message names the many victims in the world who continue to suffer today, mistreated by life or crucified unjustly. We know that God is in that suffering. That is why our commitment is clear: to defend the victims, to fight against every power that kills and dehumanizes; to wait for the final victory of God's justice that "delays but eventually comes". "Because his time is perfect".
