GOOD SHEPHERD SUNDAY - 4TH SUNDAY OF EASTER - VOCATIONS SUNDAY

In New Zealand the biblical image of the "Good Shepherd" does not 'gel' very well since we have 25 million sheep. Our sheep don't have personal pet names. The shepherd does not walk in front calling the sheep by name and having them follow. Here we have dogs who control great mobs of sheep. There is nothing personal or "gentle Jesus" about our shepherds.

In Spanish, sheep are sometimes called "borregos" which is a pejorative word also used for people who are dumb, don't think for themselves, follow the mob, and are like our kiwi idea of sheep.

The Gospels describe Jesus as concerned for the sick, the marginalised, the little ones, the most defenceless and forgotten, the most lost. The image of Him, as the "Good Shepherd", has become one of comfort and confidence. Psalm 22: is attributed to Him "The Lord is my shepherd, I shall not want... even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I fear no evil, for you are with me... Your goodness and your mercy are with me all the days of my life."



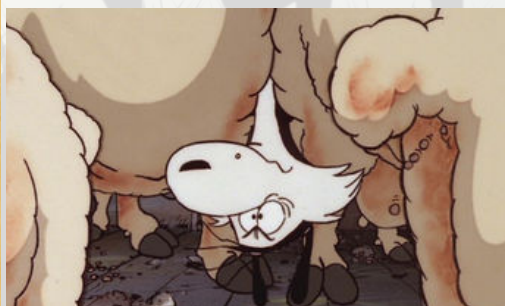
We who are the sheep who follow the Good Shepherd can't possibly be "borregos" or like those many kiwi animals that 'Wal's Dog in Footrot Flats' caters for.

Pope Francis this Good Shepherd Sunday says: "Rise up!" Let us awaken from sleep, leave indifference behind, open the doors of the prison in which we so often enclose ourselves, and discover our proper vocation in the world, as pilgrims of hope and builders of peace! Let's be passionate about life, commit ourselves to caring lovingly for those around us, in every place where we live. Let's have the courage to commit! No one is so poor as to have nothing to give, and no one is so rich as not to need something to receive."

And please pray that among those vocations, that the Priestly and Religious Life ones be more numerous, wholesome and passionate.
