FIFTH SUNDAY OF EASTER DIRECT CONTACT WITH JESUS Jn 15, 1 - 8

Before dying, Jesus insists: "Abide in me". He knows the cowardice and mediocrity of his disciples. He has often complained to them about their little faith. If they do not remain vitally united to him, they will not be able to survive.

"As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself unless it abides in the vine, neither can you unless you abide in me." If you do not hold fast to what you have learned and lived together with him, your life will be barren. If you do not live by his Spirit, what was initiated by him will be extinguished. "I am the vine and you are the branches."

In the disciples the sap that comes from Jesus must flow. "He who abides in me and I in him, he bears much fruit, for without me you can do nothing".

Let's live by his gospel. "The words that I have spoken to you are spirit and life." The visible presence and concrete voice of Jesus are found in the Gospels, the most important pastoral instrument we have.

Many Christians in our communities only know the Gospels "**second hand**". from what they have been able to learn from whanau, preachers and catechists. They live their faith without having a personal contact with "**the words of Jesus**".

It is necessary to help people to have direct contact with the Gospels. Nothing has more evangelizing power than the experience of listening together to the Gospel of Jesus and relating it to the questions, problems, sufferings and hopes of our times.
