SIXTH SUNDAY OF EASTER FROM FEAR TO LOVE John 15:9 - 17

"As the Father has loved me, so have I loved you: abide in my love". This is the heart of the Christian faith. Only by "abiding in love" can we walk in the right direction.

We don't always remain in this love. Fear can be a problem and past preaching has often ignored God's love, suffocating that initial, lively and contagious joy that Christianity has.

The bad news of a threatening God replaced "his unfathomable love" thus causing a general rejection because it makes such a God seem to be suffocating Christian faith can only be lived, as a positive, trusting and joyful experience.

The rejection of God is played out if we perceive him as a relentless watcher of our conduct, a God to be avoided. If we experience him as a friend who drives our life, we will seek him out with joy. So we must move from fear to love of Him.

Undoubtedly there is a fear of God that is healthy and fruitful "the beginning of wisdom" **when we fear spoiling our life by closing ourselves to him**. This fear awakens a person from superficiality and makes him turn to God.

The watcher image of God moves us further away from him. deforms his true being as God, making him inhuman and fear invoking.

For many, the decisive change is to move from the fear of God, which engenders a disguised rejection, to a trust in him that brings about the joy promised by Jesus: **"I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and that your joy may be complete."**
