“LORD JESUS, SON OF DAVID, HAVE PITY ON ME”

Mark 10:46-52

Bartimaeus, in his world is considered useless, is a blind Beggar ignored by society, whose only worldly possession is a blanket which he uses at night to keep out the cold and during the day to spread before him for passersby to throw their offerings of coins or food.

His blindness makes his hearing exceptionally acute, so he hears that Jesus is near; that he cures people; and that he is from the family of David from whence the Messiah is to come. So, he repeatedly calls out to Him:

“LORD JESUS, SON OF DAVID, HAVE PITY ON ME”

The people ignore him. He must stand for himself; He keeps shouting out. Jesus hears him, maybe as a slight whimper from the crowd. Jesus sends for him and when the people tell him he throws his most valuable and only belonging aside, his blanket, then rushes forward to Jesus who says.

“What do you want me to do for you?”

He replies:

“Master, that I may see”

AND SEE HE DOES

“Go your way;” says Jesus

“Your faith has saved you.”

The useless and ignored (the blind, the lame) have a privileged place in God’s heart.

Maybe each of us in some way like the blind man are like the “ignored”, “the blind, the lame, the dumb, the deaf, and in some ways the miserable and poor of this world?”

Shut your eyes and call out :

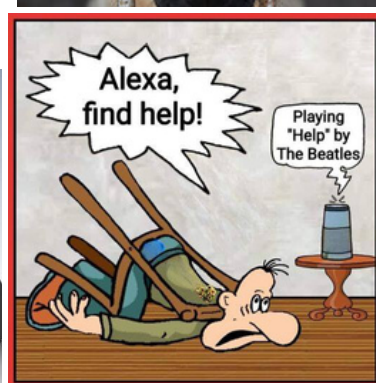
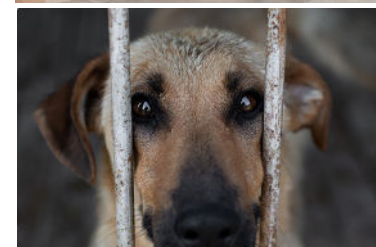
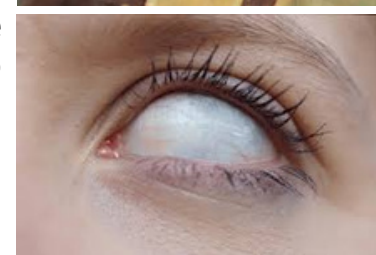
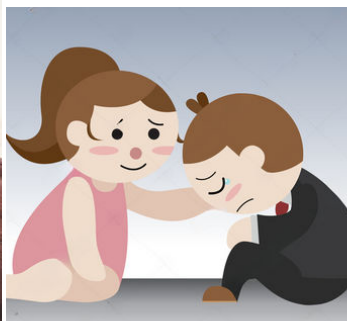
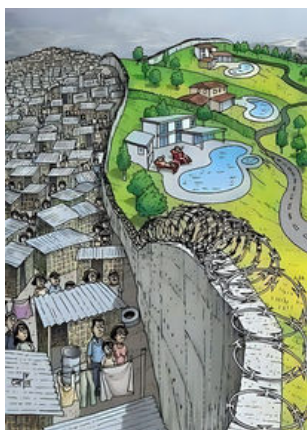
“LORD JESUS, SON OF DAVID, HAVE PITY ON ME”
