JESUS SETS THINGS STRAIGHT AGAIN

Mark 12:28b-34

The message today is nothing new. The love of God bit, the Jews called the "Shema" "God is the only Lord: you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, with all your being". They prayed it morning and night.

Love of Neighbour was also a central theme: "You shall love your neighbour as yourself."

Somehow or another, this connection of the two was heard in a new and fresh way when spoken by Jesus.

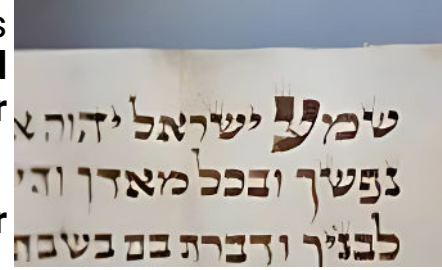
"To love" is the only healthy way of living before God and before people. If in politics or in religion, in social life or in individual behaviour, there is no love, then it is worthless.

For Jesus "God" and "neighbour" are inseparable. **It is not possible to love God and disregard one's neighbour nor love ones neighbour and disregard God.**

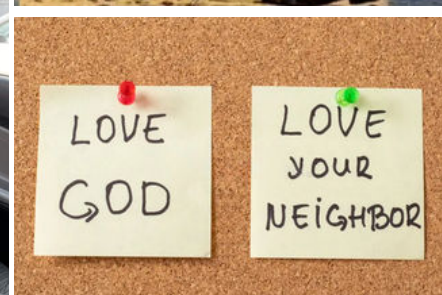
There is no sacred realm in which we can be alone with God, ignoring others. It is not possible to adore God in the depths of one's soul and live forgetting those who suffer. Love for God, Father of all, that excludes our neighbour is reduced to a lie. What goes against love, goes against God.

This is how we really get a life.




