THE TRANSFIGURATION

ALL ABOUT JESUS — WHO HE IS, WHAT HE HAS DONE, AND WHAT MATTERS.

The Transfiguration is when Jesus took three of his disciples, Peter, James, and John, up on a mountain where Moses and Elijah appeared and Jesus was transfigured, his face and clothes becoming dazzlingly bright (Luke 9:28–36).

This appearance was an affirmation of Jesus as fulfilling the promises of the law and the prophets of the Old Testament, as well as affirming that Jesus is the Messiah.

It occurs on a mountain (Tabor) in the presence of Peter, James and John, the first to be initially called by Jesus.

Jesus's appearance changes to bright white as He is praying. The three disciples sleep just as they slept in the Garden of Gethsemane.

This special Theophany (Revelation) indicates that just as Moses liberated the Chosen People in the Exodus from Egypt, Jesus will liberate all mankind through his passion, death and Resurrection, the new Exodus.

On witnessing Jesus' Transfiguration and seeing Jesus with Elijah and Moses, the disciples hear a voice from heaven, just like when Jesus was baptised in the Jordan by John.

"This is my chosen Son; listen to him."


The disciples kept secret what they had seen because they were confused and sleepy. But when Jesus dies and rises, they understand.

Jesus is the fulfilment of the New and the Old Testament.


This is the big revelation for us to accept in faith as we journey to Easter. As we **fast, pray and give** to the needy, to hear and believe that Jesus as the Chosen Son to whom we must listen and place our trust in.

Have you yourself ever had a "Transfiguration experience in your life where you, like the apostles felt good and in an elevated space? Sometimes Jesus allows us to feel this and close to Him and have something to remember and cherish, something to sustain us in hard
